1.	Completed Medical Exam form (including lab tests)

	HIV antibody testBlood test results for Hepatitis A, B & C
2.	\$1,500 Application Fee
3.	At least one set of twin sheets, pillow, pillowcase, laundry bag, clothes hangers, shower shoes, 2 towels and washcloths
4.	Dress clothes for church: include dress shoes, dress or dress pants and shirt, dress belt, tie (jeans and tennis shoes are not allowed for church)
5.	One week's supply of work clothes and casual clothes with collars (polo style ok)
6.	Personal hygiene items (soap, shampoo, toothpaste, deodorant, shaving cream, razors, etc.) (No alcohol based or aerosol products)
7.	Bible or Study Bible, notebook, notebook paper, pens, pencils, stationery, stamps, etc.
8.	200 – 3x5 index cards
9.	Driver's license or some form of picture ID and Social Security Card (important)
10	Hair to be neat and trimmed
11	No personal vehicles on campus
12	No Money of any kind is to be left with student. Wal-Mart cards are permitted.
13	No contact with anyone except immediate legal family: parents, grandparents, legal husband, children, brothers, sisters. Visitation is limited to a total of five family members at a time.
